Campus Rules

Alcohol, Tobacco and Illegal Substances Policy

No alcohol, tobacco, vaping products, or any recreational drugs/illegal substances are permitted anywhere on campus.

Bicycles, Skateboards, Scooters and Sticks

Keep wheeled sports equipment off the grass and out of buildings, including housing!

Building Access

- Enter and leave campus buildings and housing suites by using the doors. Entering/exiting through windows is prohibited.
- Do not climb onto the walls, roof, ledges, railings, or on any structure on campus.

Campus Grounds

- Do not tamper with or rearrange any landscape vegetation or hardscape, artwork, or architectural structures anywhere on campus.
- Stay out of rock-lined drainage zones, garden beds, trees, fountains, sports fields, and areas designated as "Off Limits".
- Do not move outdoor furnishings or use them for other than their intended purpose.

Curfew/Quiet Hours - 10:30 PM - 6:00 AM

- Campus gates close at 11:00PM.
- Guests housed off-campus must exit the university grounds by curfew.
- Guests housed on-campus should be in their suites during curfew/quiet hours.
- Music, voices and noise must not disturb others during these times.
- If a neighbor asks you to be quieter please respect their request.

Parking Restrictions

Do not park in Delivery zones, Handicap or blue-lined (staff) spaces

Pets

No pets are allowed anywhere on campus, inside or outside.

Signage

Please follow instructions on NITOC and Union University signs posted throughout the campus. If signs indicate an area of campus is off limits, please stay out!

Appliances

- Coffee pots, crock pots, microwaves, and toaster ovens may be brought; however, deep fryers and hot plates may not be used.
- Irons should have an automatic-off feature. No ironing on beds or carpets.
- To avoid potential safety hazards, all electrical appliances should be no more than 1000 watts and must have "UL" approval and be properly maintained.

Candles, Incense, Open Flames

Candles (including birthday candles), open flames, and incense are not permitted anywhere in on-campus housing.

Fire Hazards

Containers that contain any flammable materials/liquids are considered fire hazards and are not permitted in the suites.

Furniture

- Each suite is equipped with university furniture, which can be moved within the suite but must be used in the way it was designed.
- Furniture is not to be removed from your suite and must be in the original location and condition when you check out.

Keys

- All suite-mates are mutually responsible for keeping the living room door locked, windows locked and keys under control for the security of persons and property.
- Report any problem with your key or lock immediately. Do not loan out your keys, tamper with the lock, prop the door open, or hide keys.
- Lost keys will result in a \$25/key replacement fee to Union.

Laundry

- Residents with laundry units in their suite are required to clean the lint traps in their unit. Failure to do so will cause a mechanical malfunction of the unit, and the residents will be responsible for all charges associated with the repair or replacement of the unit.
- You are responsible for furnishing your own laundry detergent.
- Laundry facilities for Heritage is located on the first floor of the McAfee Commons.

Maintenance Requests - Do not contact UU Security for maintenance issues!

- During tournament hours: go to the Housing Desk in Bowld for TP, plunger, light bulbs, smoke detector batteries, reporting maintenance needs, etc.
- Emergency repair issues such as water leaks should be reported immediately.
- Maintenance personnel will knock and announce their presence before entering a suite.

Safety and Security

Fire Safety

- Evacuation routes are posted in each room or suite.
- All residence facilities are equipped with fire protection devices including smoke detectors, emergency lights, fire alarms, fire extinguishers, and exit lights.
- Tampering with or misuse of any fire protection device will result in immediate disciplinary action and up to a \$200 fine.

Loss and Theft Liability

- Union University and Stoa assume no responsibility for any loss or damage to personal possessions resulting from theft, fire, power outages, water, or other disasters.
- Guests are urged to take all possible precautions to protect their belongings (including locking the door, proper surge protection for electronics, and taking valuable personal belongings with you).
